These lines, which King Henry speaks in the first scene of the play, set the stage for the conflict between Prince Harry and Hotspur. Henry describes the fame and fortune of young Hotspur (the son of "my Lord Northumberland"), calling him "the theme of honour's tongue"; in comparison, he says, Prince Harry ("my young Harry") has been sullied by "riot and dishonour."
